2017 Most Valuable Student Contest

The Elks 'Most Valuable Student Contest' Applications for the 2017 contest will be available online starting September 1, 2016 at elks.org under the Elks National Foundation tab. The 2017 MVS application deadline is November 30, 2016.

Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply. The top 20 MVS finalists will attend the Most Valuable Student Leadership Weekend from April 6-9, 2017, in Chicago to interview for the top awards of \$50,000, \$40,000 and \$30,000. The remaining 14 finalists will receive \$20,000 each. 480 other deserving national finalists will receive \$4,000 scholarships to support their college education.

2017 Legacy Awards Contest

The Elks 'Legacy Awards Contests' are \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of Elks members. Online enrollment opens on September 1, 2016 at elks.org under the Elks National Foundation tab, and are due online by February 3, 2017, at 12:00 p.m. (Noon).

250 students who exhibit the values of the Elks National Foundation will be awarded a \$4,000 scholarship to support their college education.




