Again thank you for everything you do! Happy and safe holidays!

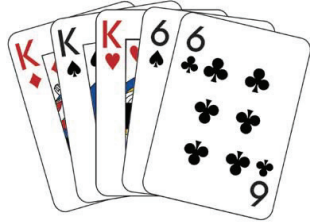

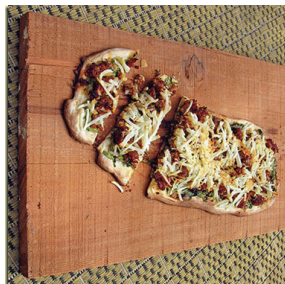
