## 2018 Most Valuable Student Contest

The 2018 Most Valuable Student scholarship contest is open to any high school senior who is a US Citizen. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. Applications for the 2018 contest are available online September 1, 2017. The 2018 MVS application deadline is November 27, 2017

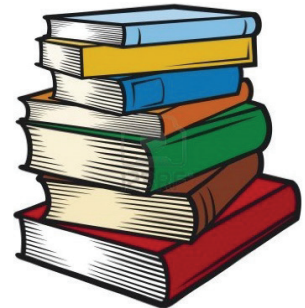
The 20 top finalists will participate in an all-expenses paid Leadership Weekend in Chicago during which they'll interview with the national judges. These 20 finalists will be vying for two first-place awards of \$50,000; two second-place awards of \$40,000; and two third-place awards of \$30,000. The remaining 14 finalists will receive awards of \$20,000. The 480 runners-up will receive fifth-place scholarships of \$4,000.

## 2018 Legacy Awards Contest

Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of Elks members. The Foundation will offer a total of 300 awards in the 2018 contest, an increase of 50 awards.

The 2018 contest opened on September 1, 2017. The deadline for applications for the 2018 contest will be February 2, 2018 at 11:59 a.m. Central Time.
